Sarah Rhodes welcomed and thanked all for attending. Attendees briefly introduced themselves.

#### **Approval of January 2020 Minutes**

Motion to approve January 2020 meeting minutes carried.

### **Treasurer's Report (Jennifer Enson)**

Update on the current status of the 2019-2020 budget as of 1/31//2020 (distributed). Presented and discussed proposed 2020-2021 budget and priorities. Exploring assemblies for all grades; all students.

Discussed possibility of bringing back Fall Fest/Carnival for 2020-2021 school year.

#### President's Report (Sarah Rhodes)

A motion was made to continue funding 7 part-time instructional assistants at an anticipated costs of \$97,951 and 1 site tech at 0.4FTE (2 days/week) at an anticipated cost of \$31,209 in the Bancroft PFC operating budget for 2020-2021. Motion was seconded and passed with majority vote (1 abstention).

DIscussed streamlining PFC bylaws and consolidating positions and re-writing descriptions.

#### Teachers' reports

Mrs. Parker provided updates on 100/120th day celebrations; STEAM lab and Garden, writing and reading; 1st grade Animal Habitat project; cooking and nutrition lessons. Mrs. Alisa Kutsel (STEAM Lab Assistant) presented Cooking with Garden & STEAM: successful schoolwide program.

# **Committee Reports**

**Family Multicultural Night 1/31:** approx. 100 attendees; three performances (e.g., Brazillian Capoeira dance); country boothes (India, Israel, Korea, Russia, etc.); five raffle prizes distributed to students; passports needed more communication/explanation

**Recruitment Nomination Committee**: Volunteers needed to help recruit PFC board and committee members for next year. Contact Ben Nie if interested.

**Afterschool Enrichment**: Basketball, Tennis, and Soccer starting soon. Volunteer leader needed for 2020-2021.

**Strategic Funds**: Two Toss N Score basketball games have been purchased for main blacktop; working with District to find date to install. Will determine if balls are needed. Returning \$4,332 back to free cash.

**Dine to Donate**: Yalla's 2/19 50% of purchase donated to Bancroft PFC.

**Auction 3/21**: 2/3 of tickets sold with 40-50 remaining. New this year: teachers must register themselves on the website. This year: many new items, many buy-in parties, new caterer. Dianne Adair will offer night of care. Looking for someone to volunteer to take the lead next year.
