Approval of October 2023 Minutes Motion to approve October 2023 meeting minutes was passed given fixes to typos.

Financial Report/Budget Update

Yotam Levine went through the current budget and explained the line item income and expenses (available on Konstella). There were some questions on where the book fair income number came from, some follow up needed to verify that. There was also a discussion about right sizing projected expenses and income for the rest of the year given lower dollar-a-day participation on the income side and less realized expenses for the IAs to date, given the discussion we are updating projected expenses soft funded positions (Line 41 in Expenses) for IAs from 77k to 38k, Math Intervention from 40k to 30k and Counselor from 20k to 10k.

We have all been busy with assessments and report cards which will be available this Friday.

We enjoyed a fun Halloween, including our school parade and learned more about Dia de los Muertos.

4th grade

All students are reading <u>Save Me a Seat</u> and practicing predicting and inferring. This book provides great opportunities for good conversations and the students are loving it.

In math we are working problem solving using all four operations and beginning fractions.

In Social Studies we are learning about the Mission System and California under Mexican Rule. We have had some great ZOOM field trips to State Parks. All 4th graders can get a pass to California State Parks. Parents can enroll online. Libraries also have lending passes for Parks if your family is interested you can check one out with your library card.

We continue working on writing narratives, improving skills of formatting and punctuation.

All classes have now experienced Los Vaqueros in Brentwood.

In Earth Science, we are making model stream tables to study erosion and then layering to form a model for fossils.

5th grade

Writing Personal Narratives continues with a focus on strong introductions and conclusions.

In Math students are working on fractions and decimals. Some special projects in math include Fraction Feast, Thanksgiving meal planning, and a pizza party project.

Science continues with Physical and Chemical Changes in Matter in two classes and Earth Systems in two classes.

In Social Studies students have been studying Explorers and will be doing an Explorer Project.
