4th grade:

All fourth graders just completed our CA History Projects and we had a wonderful time walking through the showcase to see the hard work of our peers. We wrote our own informative essays in class after doing research, we did an at-home project, completed an oral presentation, as well as a peer review and self review.

Our classes have been enjoying our virtual field trips where we are able to have private tours through our state and national monuments and parks here in California, led by a park ranger or interpreter. We do note-taking and ask questions throughout our tours--they have given us such excellent knowledge about our great state of California! Our students are excited to one day visit many of these locations.

Students are going to start reading Dear Mr. Henshaw and the students will be learning how to summarize using the SWBST close reading strategy.

In math Students are learning how to relate decimals and fractions. Next group of math RTI have started with Ms. Masey and focused on adding and subtracting with regrouping.

Opinion writing is our focus for the 3rd trimester. Spanish classes are focusing on Informative. In Social Studies we are learning about WWII.
